1. That the above sanctioned GIA is exclusively meant for conducting the SNCU Data Management Trainings w.e.f. 23rd -24th Nov, 2015 at Srinagar and 26th -27th Nov, 2015 at Jammu under RCH Flexible Pool during the year 2015-16.
2. That the funds sanctioned are to be utilized strictly **as per the enclosed budget sheet** and guidelines issued by the MoH&FW, GoI and after observing all codal formalities required under rules (**strictly no cash payments**).
3. That all the funds shall accept on the portal of PFMS after confirming same from the bank account and subsequently to ensure timely filing of expenditure on the PFMS portal.
4. That the timely compliance to be done of the observations raised in the Statutory Audit Report 2014-15.
5. That the proper record of Bank Column Cash Book, Ledger, Assets and other relevant record are to be maintained for check of any visiting team Central/State Govt.
6. That the monthly statements of expenditure and utilisation certificate are sent to the State Health Society regularly.
7. That the accounts of the grantee shall be opened to the inspection by the sanctioning authority and Audit both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal Audit by Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, whenever the society is called upon to do so.
