
In reference to above mentioned communication and as per the approval conveyed by the MoH&FW, Govt. of India in NHM State PIP for the year 2018-19, sanction is hereby accorded to the release of Grant-in-Aid of **Rs.200.00 Lac (Rupees Two Hundred Lac Only)** under Routine Immunization for Measles-Rubella SIA operational cost to be undertaken during the year 2018-19 under NHM. However, further funds shall be released only after receipt of Utilization Certificate and Physical achievements for onward submission to the MoH&FW, GoI as per the conditionalities DoE.

Accordingly, the above sanctioned GIA is transferred to your official Bank A/C No. **04050187** of Jammu & Kashmir Bank Ltd, Nagrota, Jammu.

The Grant-in-Aid released is subject to following conditions:

1. That the above sanctioned funds are to be utilized for **Measles Rubella SIA operational cost** approved under Routine Immunization as per Budget Sheet and as per the guidelines issued by the MoH&FW, GoI in this regard after observing all codal formalities required under rules.
2. That no diversion of funds is permissible without approval of the Competent Authority.
3. That all the payments/expenditure is to be done only through e-transfer (**No cash payments**).
4. That the Directorate should be registered as agency on PFMS portal to enable this office for release of further funds under NHM as per the conditionalities of MoH&FW, GoI
5. That the monthly Statement of Expenditure (SOE) and Utilization Certificate (UC) in GFR 19A be sent to State Health Society regularly.
6. That the proper record of Bank Column Cash Books, Ledgers, Assets Register and other relevant records is maintained for inspection of any visiting team from Central/State Government.
7. That the account of the grantee shall be opened to inspection by the sanctioning authority and Audit both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and Internal Audit by Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, GoI. Whenever the institution/society is called upon to do so.
8. That the above sanctioned funds are to be transferred immediately to the concerned District Health Societies/other implementing agencies within 2 days through e-transfer under intimation to the State Health Society, J&K.
